Tiruvannamalai, Feb. 18: Tiruvannamalai Collector K. Tharpararaj, on Tuesday, flagged off an awareness campaign vehicle at the District Collectorate campus to publicise the upcoming Mega Private Sector Job Fair scheduled to be held in the district.

The job fair is being organised by the District Administration in coordination with the District Employment and Career Guidance Centre functioning under the Department of Employment and Training, along with the Tamil Nadu Rural/Urban Livelihood Mission (Mahalir Thittam). The mega recruitment drive will take

place on February 22 at Arignar Anna Government Arts College, Cheyyar.

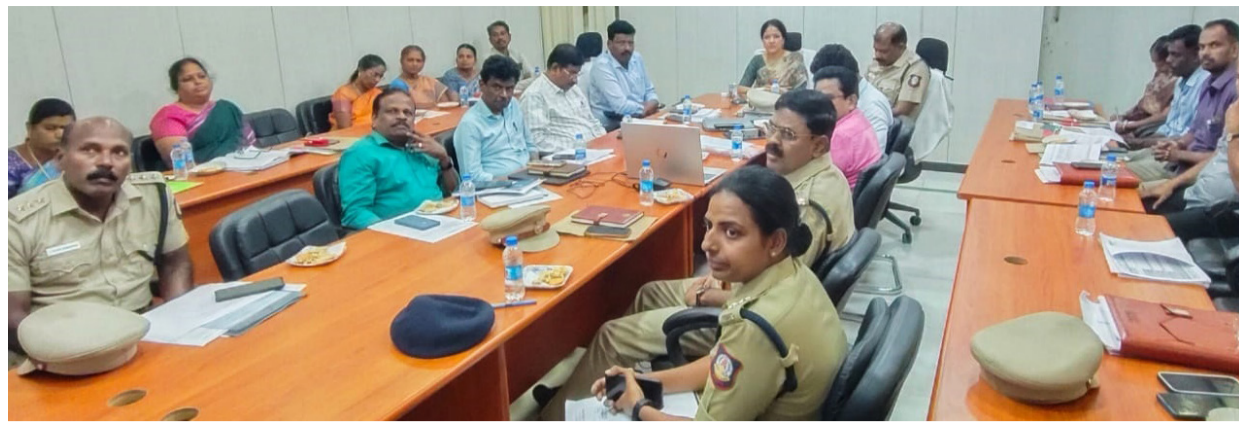
According to official sources, more than 120 leading private companies and skill training institutions will participate in the fair, offering over 7,000 job vacancies. On-the-spot interviews will be conducted, and eligible candidates will be selected directly by participating employers.

Candidates aged between 18 and 35 years can participate in the job fair. Interested applicants are required to register their details online at <https://tprivatejobs.tn.gov.in>

They have been advised to bring passport-size photographs, educational certificates, Aadhaar card and resume while attending the fair.

The awareness vehicle will tour various parts of Tiruvannamalai district, particularly areas with large public gatherings, to spread information about the employment opportunity among youth and the general public.

## Dhinakaran slams DMK Interim Budget

Chennai, Feb 18: AMMK General Secretary T.T.V. Dhinakaran has strongly criticised the interim financial statement tabled in the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly by the DMK government led by Chief Minister M.K. Stalin, terming it an "illusionary model report" that has disappointed the people of the state. In a sharply worded statement, he said that while expectations were high ahead of the presentation, the document ultimately failed to deliver meaningful welfare-oriented announcements.

He alleged that the report was filled with self-praise rather than concrete measures addressing public concerns.

Dhinakaran remarked that large portions of the interim financial statement highlighted the achievements of the DMK government over the past five years under various headings, including Tamil language development, welfare of Sri Lankan Tamils, children, women, persons with disabilities, senior citizens and transgender persons. "On reading these pages, one is left wondering whether this is a financial statement or merely another government press release," he said, suggesting that the document focused more on projecting the government's image than presenting fiscal clarity.

He further criticised the government's portrayal of Tamil Nadu as one of India's most peaceful

states, pointing to incidents of murder, robbery, crimes against women, drug proliferation, illegal liquor sales, 'katta panchayats', and the alleged rise of an illicit firearms culture. According to him, describing the law-and-order situation in glowing terms in the interim report was "regrettable and far removed from ground realities." He contended that the administration had failed to address deteriorating public safety and governance standards.

Highlighting what he described as shortcomings in public services, Dhinakaran referred to inadequate infrastructure in government schools, hospitals functioning under distress, and inefficiencies in government offices. He argued that despite this being the final interim financial statement before the next Assembly

elections, the DMK government had not introduced any substantial new welfare schemes. He also questioned why the voices of protesting groups—including persons with disabilities seeking enhanced assistance, panchayat secretaries demanding inclusion in pension schemes, and guest lecturers pressing for salary revision—"were not heard within the Assembly."

On the fiscal front, Dhinakaran accused the government of failing to increase state revenue through constructive measures during its five-year tenure and instead relying heavily on borrowings. He claimed that Tamil Nadu had been pushed to the forefront among Indian states in terms of debt accumulation and pointed out that the interim statement

proposes to raise an additional Rs.1,79,809 crore in loans. "This once again proves that there is no connection between the DMK government and administrative efficiency," he asserted, adding that rising fiscal deficits and declining capital expenditure reflected mismanagement.

He also criticised the government for allegedly shifting blame onto the Union Government to mask its own shortcomings and expressed concern over the interim agricultural financial statement, which he said offered little new support to farmers. Referring to delays in compensation during natural disasters such as floods and cyclones, he claimed that farmers had not received timely relief.

## Sept 26 last date for updating birth certificates

Kancheepuram, Feb 18: District Collector Kalaichelvi Mohan, has announced that the deadline for registering a child's name in the birth certificate has been extended until September

26, 2026. Emphasizing that birth registration is a child's first right, the Collector stated that a birth certificate serves as legal proof of citizenship. Under the Registration of

Births and Deaths Act, 1969, parents are required to register the birth of a child within 21 days to obtain a free birth certificate. However, the certificate is considered complete only when the child's name is entered.

A birth certificate is a mandatory document for school admission, obtaining a voter ID card, driving licence, passport, visa, and even for acquiring citizenship in a foreign country.

If a child's birth was registered without a name, parents or guardians may submit a written declaration to the concerned Registrar of Births and Deaths within 12 months from the date of registration to add the name free of cost. Between 12 months and 15 years, the name can be registered on payment of a late fee of Rs.200. However, after 15 years, adding the name is not permitted under the rules.

As per the advisory of the Chief Registrar of Births in India, individuals born before January 1, 2000 were previously granted time until September 30, 2014 (counting 15 years from 2000) to register their names in birth certificates. Subsequently, due to a large number of pending cases, the deadline was extended by five years up to December 31, 2024.

In view of continued demand for additional time, the government has now granted a further extension until September 26, 2026.

Those who have not yet registered the name in the birth certificate may apply to the concerned Municipal Commissioner, Tahsildar, or Town Panchayat Officer where the birth was originally registered. The District Collector has urged the public to make use of this rare opportunity and obtain a complete birth certificate with the child's name on or before September 26, 2026.
